



Fort William Ben Nevis & the Isle of Skye



Fort William is a town in Lochaber in the Scottish Highlands, located on the eastern shore of Loch Linnhe. Known as the gateway to UK's highest peak, Ben Nevis and to the Glen Nevis valley, home to Steall Falls. Popular for outdoor activities including skiing and snowboarding, quad biking, fishing, sailing, pony trekking and even bush craft and survival courses there is something for all abilities and adrenalin levels! If you're not feeling quite so energetic, more laidback alternatives include The West Highland Museum, St Andrew's Church and Inverlochy castle.

Whilst on this side of the country you should allocate a day or two to visit the Isle of Skye. Cuillin ridge with its Fairy Pools. Kilt rock. The Quiraing range. The Old Man of Storr. All of these incredible places serve to create some of the most dramatic scenery Scotland has to offer. Travel to Neist Point Lighthouse for a tranquil end to your day and watch the sun set from the most westerly point of the island.
