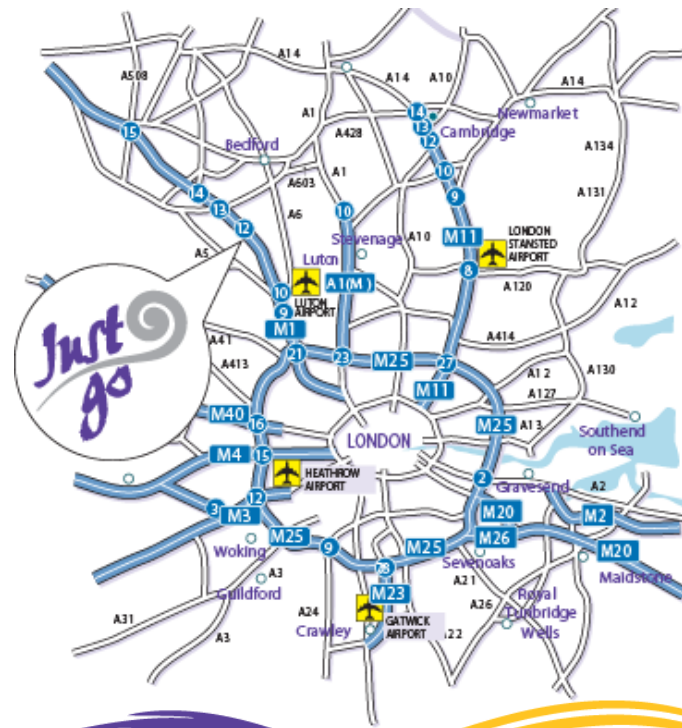

Good idea



Keep hold of your keys - Make sure you have the keys with you so they don't get locked in the motorhome! There is only 1 set of keys for the motorhome, however, if you split the habitation door key from the main ignition/cab key, this will enable two people access into the vehicle.

Water - It may not be possible to move your motorhome when you are parked at an event. Please plan ahead to make sure you have filled up your fresh water and emptied your grey water tank to enable you to use your water during your stay.

And finally....

Enjoy! - An outdoor event can be the most unforgettable time of your summer.

A bit of planning can go a really long way at an event and we hope this guide will help you have a great time, so take care of yourself and each other and we look forward to seeing you upon your return.



Remember....



Mark your motorhome - You may find more than one Just go motorhome at your festival or event, so it could be a good idea to make sure you know which motorhome is yours!

A flag or sign will make your motorhome stand out and avoid any mistakes at the end of a long day! Your keys also have a fob on with the last 3 letters of your registration.

If your festival, event or campsite pitch allow vehicle movements you may wish to mark your pitch so you know where your spot is.

Be responsible with your Rubbish - Please respect the local environment and take all rubbish with you or dispose of responsibly on site.

Things to look out for...

Mud, Mud everywhere! - It wouldn't be a great British summer without a few downpours. Floor coverings or a door mat can save a lot of cleaning. Please note that there is a cleaning fee if the motorhome is not returned back to us clean and tidy.

If the weather is not kind it may be necessary for you to be towed out of the mud. Towing eyes are provided with every vehicle, so if required please call our office or check your vehicle manual for the towing eye location.
