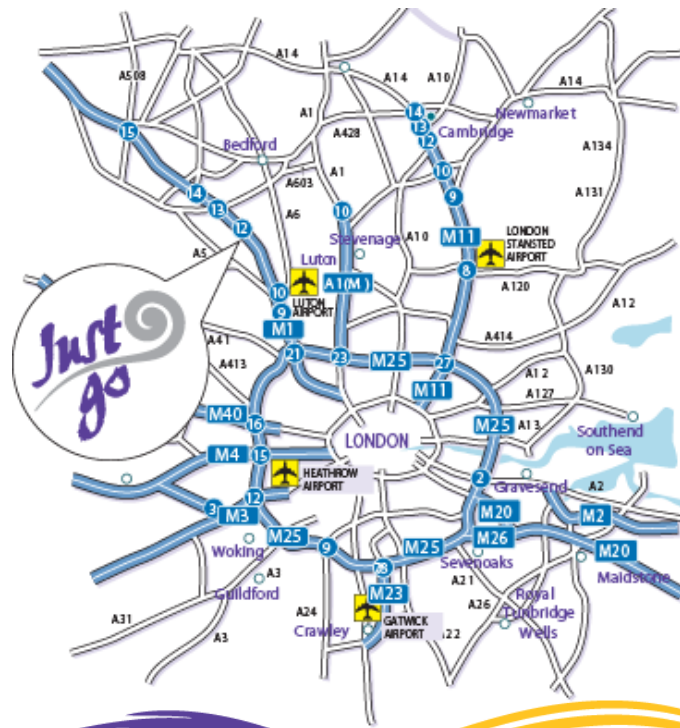
Paradise-Garden Camping

Austria, Vienna

Renowned for its musical heritage and architecture, home to past luminaries Sigmund Freud, Mozart and Beethoven, Austria's capital city has also topped the charts as one of the best cities in the world to live in.

Located in the very east of the country on the river Danube, the city centre is a UNESCO World Heritage site and is characterised by imposing and opulent architecture. The broad avenue of the Ringstrabe was created at the start of the 20th century after the original city walls were raised and is now the site of numerous Baroque palaces and parks.

Vienna continues its musical tradition in several world class Opera Houses. In the museum quarter you can view art ranging from the old masters to the contemporary works housed in the Museum of Modern Art.

The city is also home to many parks and the oldest zoo in the world. When you have tired of all the art and culture, find a quiet spot in one of the many exotic coffee houses in the city and take a well earned rest.



Places to visit

The Art Museums

With over 100 museums attracting 8 million visitors a year, even the most judgemental art critic should find something to like. Favourites include the Albertina, Belvedere, Leopold and the [Technisches Museum Wien](#).

The Viennese Coffee House

Although many people have tried to recreate the traditional Viennese coffee shop, there is nothing quite like the ones found in Vienna. The coffee is traditionally served with a glass of water and the Viennese cafes claim to have invented the filtering process after the Turkish siege of the city in 1683. Pair it with one of the traditional cakes of the region like the Satchertorte or Apfelstrudel.

The Imperial Palaces

The Schonbrunn Palace is a former 1142 room summer residence. Built in a Rococo style it charts the interests and tastes of a succession of Hapsburg Monarchs. Also home to the oldest zoo in the world, the Riesenrad, that was created in 1752 as an Imperial menagerie.
