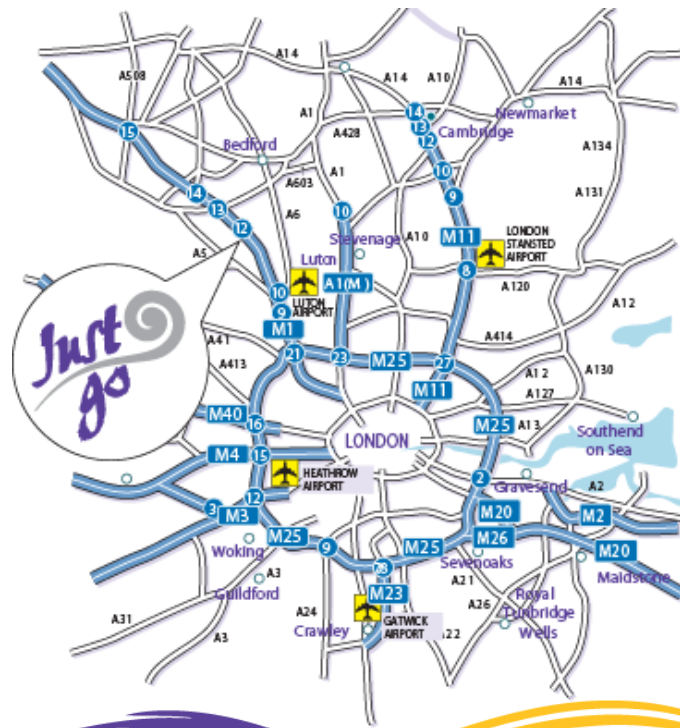


Camping Markelfingen

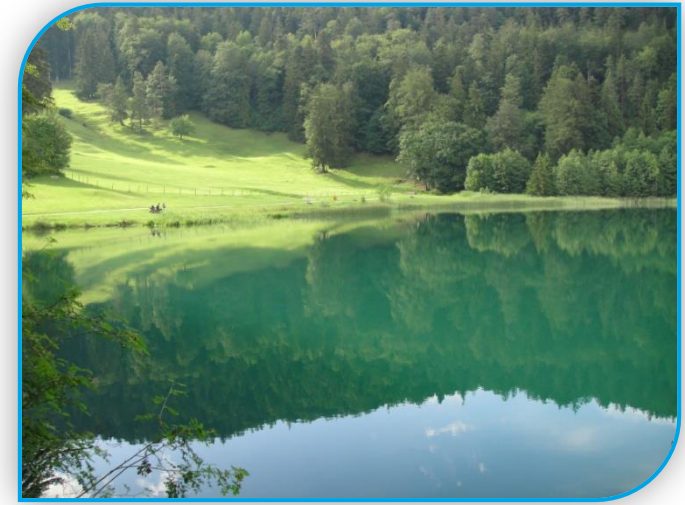

Germany, Lake Constance

Lake Constance is at the intersection of Austria, Germany and Switzerland and lies in an extremely beautiful corner of Europe. More than half of the shoreline of Lake Constance is in Germany and the views from the German shore across to the Swiss Alps are stunning. The lake is a centre for water sports, while its shores are home to swathes of vineyards and intriguing towns. The area is rich in castles, baroque churches, exquisite town squares and curious museums, while the hinterland is dotted with pretty villages and child friendly attractions.

In Friedrichshafen you can visit the Zeppelin museum. This lakeside town, once home to Count Ferdinand von Zeppelin, the creator of the airships, was a hive of activity until 1937 when the 245 meter long Hindenburg caught fire on landing in New Jersey.

Meersburg has two castles that are worthy of a visit. The Baroque Neues Schloss and the 16th century Altes Schloss. The Altes Schloss contains Germany's oldest extant castle within its walls, the building is now a museum.



Places to visit

Monastic Island of Reichenau

A perfect island to explore by bicycle, this World Heritage site has a visual history of early Monastic architecture from the middle ages through the 9th to the 11th century. The monastery was a centre for artistic life in the 11th and 12th centuries and this is superbly illustrated in its monumental wall paintings and illuminations.

Mainau

Commonly known as the Flower Island, this small Island is around 3 miles from the city of Konstanz and is reached by bridge from the shore. Created in the first half of the 19th century by Prince Nikolaus von Estehazy because of the Islands sub tropical micro climate, it has been expanded over the years to include an arboretum, Italian Rose garden and butterfly house. The flower season starts in March with Orchid shows and over a million tulips. In summer there are another 350,000 flowers to see. Open sunrise to sunset.

Monkey Mountain. (Affenberg)

Located near Lake Constance (Bodensee) in southwest Germany lies 20 hectares of forest with Germany's largest open-air monkey enclosure home to 200+ Barbary macaques. Surprisingly, Barbary macaques feel right at home in Germany, since their native origins are in the high mountains of up to 2000m in Morocco and Algeria.
