## Camping Valeiva

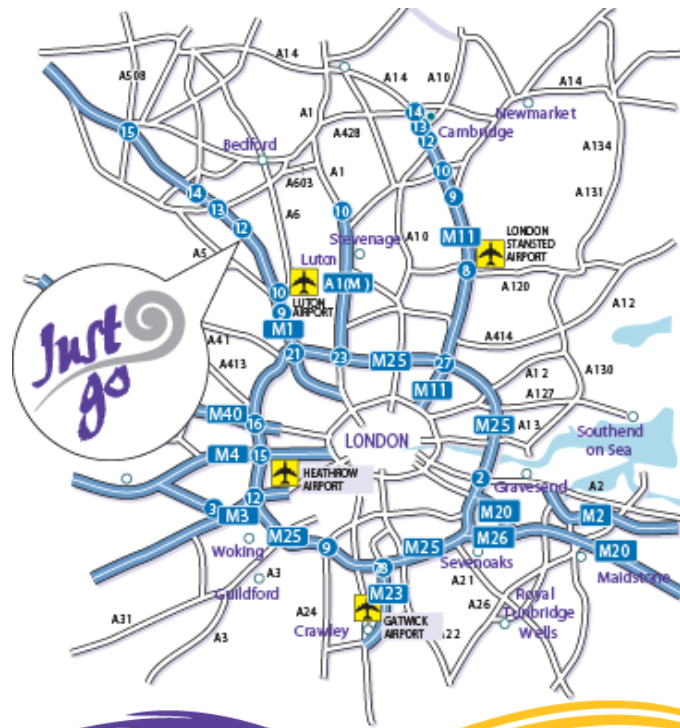
