
Pantmawr Farm



Aberystwyth

Aberystwyth is a historic market town, administrative centre and holiday resort within Ceredigion, West Wales. Located near the Rivers Ystwyth and Rheidol and provides some fantastic views.

Although the name may seem to suggest otherwise, only the River Rheidol passes through the town; following the reconstruction of the harbour, the River Ystwyth skirts the town.

Aberystwyth has a pier and a fine seafront which stretches from Constitution Hill at the north end of the Promenade to the mouth of the harbour at the south, taking in two separate beach stretches divided by the castle.

Today it is essentially made up by a number of different areas: Aberystwyth town, Llanbadarn Fawr, Waunfawr, Penparcau, Llanbadarn and Trefechan, with Penparcau being the most populous.



Places to visit

Vale of Rheidol Railway

Travelling on the Vale of Rheidol Railway is the finest way to see the stunning valley. It passes through wide open fields, woodland and rugged mountain scenery and the line twists and turns clinging to the hillside. It gradually climbs nearly 700ft from Aberystwyth to reach Devils Bridge.

Ceredigion Museum

This museum is a living mediator between past and present. They aim to reflect the history of the country through material evidence. It is based at the Coliseum, Aberystwyth with additional facilities throughout the country. Along with permanent displays the museum has a lively programme of temporary exhibitions and events. Admission is Free.
