


## Meadow Bank Holidays

The New forest with its miles of bridleways and paths to discover, are all set in scenery little changed since William the Conqueror laid out his ancient systems of woodland management.

You are likely to meet friendly wild ponies and see the deer nestled amongst the trees when you aren't walking around beautiful local villages like Brockenhurst and Lyndhurst.

The guys might be interested in Beaulieu National Motor Museum, one of the foremost motor museums in the country and if that doesn't appeal to you there are numerous Historic houses and monuments to visit.

If the weather is fine why not rent a bicycle, or take your own. Go on a pony trekking adventure or head to the New Forest Water Park where you can canoe, kayak, water ski and sail till the sun goes down.



## Places to visit

### Monkey World

An ape rescue centre that assists governments around the world in preventing the illegal trade and neglect of our primate friends. With over 250 primates of more than 20 different species on site to see, the charity side of the organisation also allows you to adopt.

### Snowtrax Alpine Activity Centre

### Buckler's Hard

This peaceful Maritime Museum and village on the banks of the Beaulieu River is where the ships for Nelson's fleet were built. Historic displays in the Labourer's and Shipwright's cottages show how the village would have looked in the 1800's. Other exhibitions cover the sinking of the P&O liner, the SS Persia by German torpedoes and a day in the life of a master shipbuilder in the late 1700's.
