



# Cheltenham & The Cotswolds

The corner of Britain known as the Cotswolds stretches over 6 counties and is the largest area of outstanding natural beauty in Britain. It covers 68 Sq miles and is characterised by beautiful honey coloured houses nestled in rolling countryside. Starting in Bath in the south west of the UK it covers an area to Oxford in the east, Cheltenham in the north and to the Welsh borders in the west.

When you have had enough fields and fresh air head into the city of Oxford and discover its scholarly history and the oldest university in the English speaking world, dating back to 1096.

Cheltenham is a town in Gloucestershire, England, home to the renowned Cheltenham Festival, 4 days of horse jump racing culminating in the Gold Cup, held annually in March at Cheltenham Racecourse. It's also known for Regency buildings, including the Pittville Pump Room, a remnant of Cheltenham's past as a spa town.

## Places to visit

### Westonbirt Arboretum

The historic, Victorian picturesque landscape lies 3 miles south of Tetbury. Whichever time of year you go you will be impressed by the collection of more than 16,000 trees and the 17 miles of well kept trails.
