



# Dartmoor & the South Devon Coast

If breathing space is what you're after, then head to Devon. There are two National Parks within its county borders jointly amounting to 1062 sq miles of open moorland, rocky outcrops and coastal forests. It's a great place to get your walking boots on and clear your head and has some amazing historical sites to reward your effort.

In Exmoor you could visit the Tarr steps, a granite flagstone 'clapper' bridge over the river Barle that has remained undisturbed for 3000 years. Or on the edge of Dartmoor the National trust owned 700 year old Buckland Abbey, once home to both Grenville and Sir Francis Drake.

If beautiful beaches are what you're looking for, you will be spoilt for choice in Devon. Near the top of the pile must be Blackpool Sands, an award winning crescent shaped beach backed by pines and evergreens 3 miles from Dartmouth.

To keep the kids entertained take them to 'Go Ape' for a tree top adventure. They can test their bravery on the two 235m zip wires. If the weather is against you Devon has plenty of attractions to keep you entertained. Try the National Marine Aquarium in Plymouth, the largest in the country or step back in time and visit the picturesque historic port of Clovelly, where the streets are narrow, cars are banned and the villagers move things by sled and donkey.



## Places to visit

### Kents Cavern

The oldest known human settlement in Britain and since 2011 when a human jawbone was found and dated to 41,000 years, the oldest settlement of this kind in Northern Europe. The cave is a labyrinth of spectacular and easy to visit caves where the kids can have a go at archaeological excavation and cave art or outside, the woodland trail quest.

### Becky Falls Woodland Park

Set within a spectacular ancient valley, Becky falls has been attracting visitors for 100 years. With stunning woodland and waterfall walks, totally hands on encounter shows and feeding sessions, there is something for all ages to enjoy.
