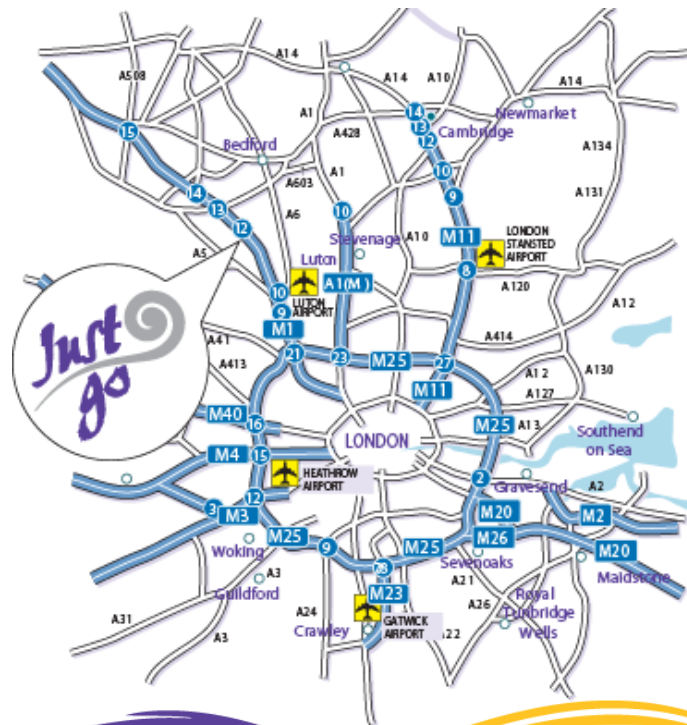
Kelham Hall & Country Park

Explore the legendary stomping ground of Robin Hood including the Major Oak a 800 year old tree which was supposedly his principle hideout. The Visitor Centre is on the B6034 just north of Edwinstowe, between the A6075 and the A616, 20 miles north of Nottingham.
