

If the motorhome is too cold you will need to pop your heating on to warm up the interior before you are able to reset the switch.

Grey Water Tank/Fresh Water

During ski season, adverse weather conditions, or if leaving the vehicle unattended for a few days, in order to avoid the water in the tanks/boiler/pipes freezing and causing damage it is advisable to empty both of these tanks.

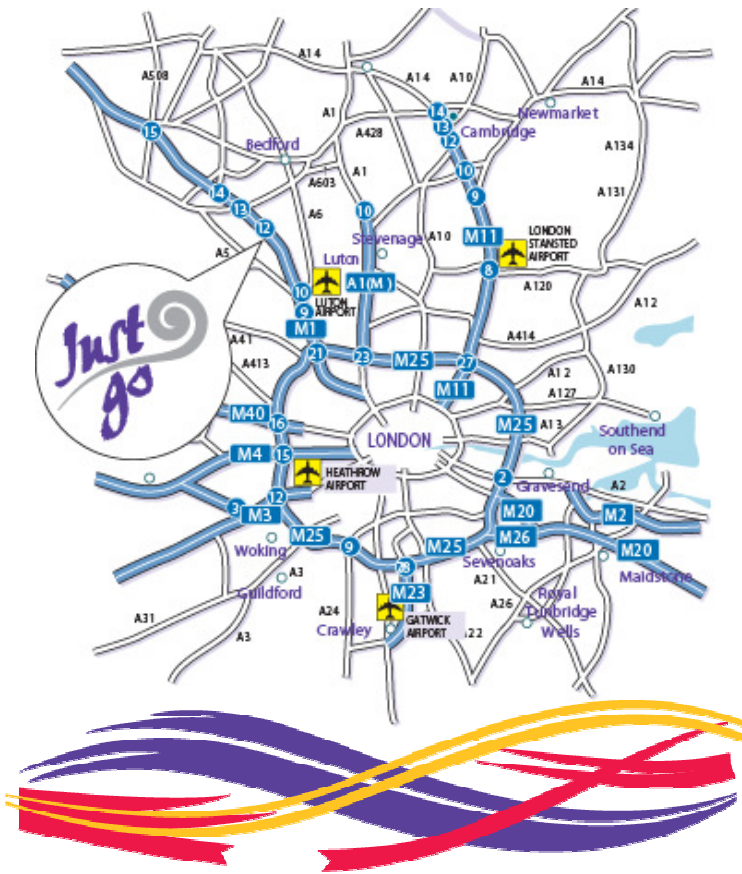
Snow Chains

If your winter trip takes you to snowy parts don't panic! Just let us know and these can be added onto your booking at an extra cost. Full instructions for fitting the chains are included in your video tour and in your side kick manual. **REMEMBER snow chains are for emergency use only.** They are not designed for prolonged use and you should not exceed 30mph/50kph.



Towing

If you find you need to be towed out of a situation the towing eye can be found in a box in the front cab. Locate the box, take out the towing eye and fit it securely into the port on the front bumper. For assistance locating the towing eye please contact the office.

For your comfort and security we recommend staying at campsites for the duration of your hire. **Please research and book your campsites ahead as some only run from April – October.**

Heating and Hot Water

Your heating, hot water and cooking operate on LPG gas, so first of all turn on the gas in the outside locker.

Locate the heating and water control. Tap rotary push button to activate your thermostat, then twist the rotary button to scroll through options and push to select. Full instructions are included in your video tour and side kick manual.



You will soon be warm and toasty! All our motorhomes use the new EVO technology which gives greater thermal insulation and greater protection from the elements.

ALWAYS REMEMBER to turn off the gas when you are driving, sleeping or leaving the motorhome unattended.

Fill up when you can

Make sure you always fill up Your LPG gas when you see it....not every filling station stocks LPG gas. There are very few filling points in N. Scotland, Ireland and Spain.



Window Sensor

Some of our models are fitted with a window sensor. The heating will not function if the window is open; close the window fully for it to work.



Silver Screen

When you are parked up, attach the silver screen on the inside of the front and side windows in the cab area, using the suckers. This will help to keep the motorhome warm and offer privacy. Take care when removing from the window. Put your nail behind the sucker and gently peel away. If you pull them they may rip through the screen.

Frost Protection Switch

All our motorhomes are fitted with a frost protection switch. If the weather is very cold or there is a sudden change of temperature the switch may trip and will release all water from the pipes underneath the motorhome. If you have the water pump on when this happens it will drain all the water from the tank until there is none left and could burn out the pump. This is why it is important to always **SWITCH OFF THE WATER PUMP WHEN NOT IN USE.**

Check the "find it" sticker in the motorhome to locate the frost protection switch. To reset it find the small blue button at the bottom of the narrow side of the box, push this back in and refill your fresh water, making sure the water pump is switched off.
