



Bournemouth Poole & the New Forest

Bournemouth is a coastal resort town on the south coast of England, east of the 96-mile-long Jurassic Coast, a World Heritage Site. At the 2011 census, the town had a population of 183,491, making it the largest in the administrative county of Dorset. It is in the historic county of Hampshire. With Poole which is a large coastal town and seaport in Dorset to the west and Christchurch which adjoins Bournemouth in the west and the New Forest lies to the east.

The New forest with its miles of bridleways and paths to discover, are all set in scenery little changed since William the Conqueror laid out his ancient systems of woodland management. You are likely to meet friendly wild ponies when you aren't walking around beautiful local villages like Brockenhurst and Lyndhurst. The guys might be interested in Beaulieu National Motor Museum, one of the foremost motor museums in the country and if that doesn't appeal to you there are numerous Historic houses and monuments to visit.
