



Canterbury & the South East Coast

The Historic City of Canterbury surrounds a UNESCO World Heritage site. The site encompasses the Cathedral, St Augustine's Abbey and St Martin's Church. The Cathedral is the religious seat of the Anglican Church and residence of the Archbishop and St. Martin's is the oldest Parish church still in use in Britain. Surrounded by beautiful countryside and coastal scenery the active among you will be rewarded with stunning views.

Try the Crab and Winkle Way, a 7 mile walking and cycling route that runs between Canterbury and Whitstable and passes through one of Britain's oldest forests. If you have something more relaxing in mind, you could punt down the river Stour for a traffic free view of the many medieval and historic buildings. Or visit a local vineyard and sample the local products. For excitement become a big cat ranger for the day or learn how to photograph these impressive animals at the Wildlife Heritage Foundation in Smarden, a short drive to the west.
