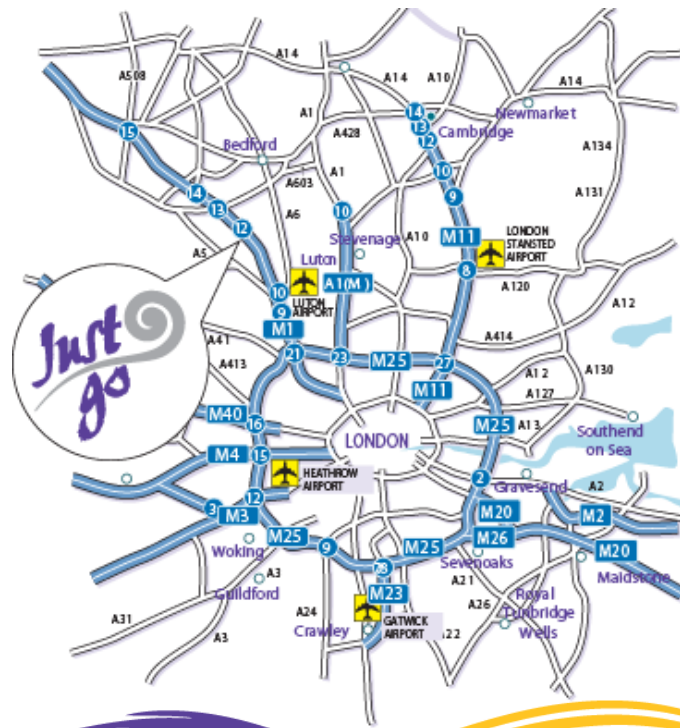


Camping Campix
