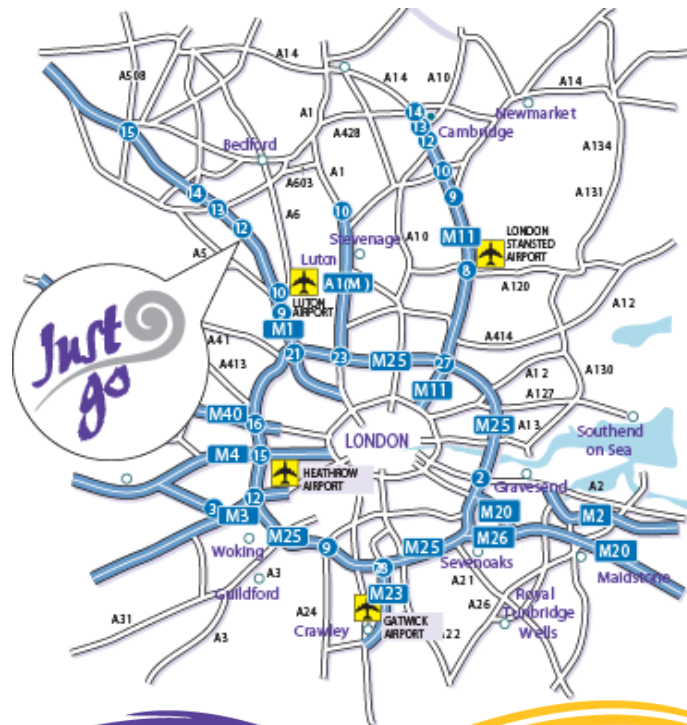


Beau Rivage Camping

France, The Ardeche

Often regarded as one of the most remote regions of France, the Ardeche is home to stunning scenery, ancient towns and the deepest gorge in Europe. Covering an area of 5500sq miles and rising to an altitude of 1754 meters in the western mountains, the landscape slopes to the south east taking in the transitional plateau's of the Haut Vivarais and Cevennes. Cut through with deep uncrossable gorges and forested peaks, the scenery is sparsely populated and difficult to cross, especially in winter.

Limestone walls rise to a 1000 feet above the Ardeche river that meanders through the dramatic Reserve Naturelle des Gorges de l'Ardeche. A magnet for water sports and climbing enthusiasts, in the summer months the area is a popular tourist destination.

Cream coloured fortified villages and cave paintings high up in the cliff sides point towards a long history of human occupation in the history of human occupation in the area, and along with dramatic naturally formed sights like the Vallon Pont du Arc and the Gours des grottes de Saint Marcel d'Ardecheit, it is a beautiful area to discover and enjoy.



Places to visit

La Grotto de st Marcel d'Ardeche

Currently 57km of underground passageways, caverns, amazing basins and immense rooms have been discovered since a hunters ferret crawled into a cavity in the cliffs near St Marcel d'Ardeche in 1836. Beautifully illuminated, the 600m circuitous route will reveal the dramatic sights of this underground world.

Accroche Toi aux Branches

An adventure and tree climbing park with over 1500 meters of zip wires and walkways to navigate. Numerous levels of difficulty to suit all ages and experience.

Chateau de Ventadour

The ruined Chateau de Ventadour has perched in its dramatic location 75 meters above the confluence of the Ardeche and Fontoliere rivers since the 11th century. It has undergone an extensive period of restoration since 1969 at which point it had been a ruin since 1789.
